



More news to keep you updated on existing initiatives at the border. Five years have passed since FAST cards became available and today there are in excess of 87,000 North American truck drivers registered in the program. Those who were accepted and issued a card should check the expiry date on the front of their card.

FAST cards have been accepted as alternative document for proof of identity and citizenship when entering the United States. The FAST card also permits a Canadian driver to move Hazardous Materials when accompanied with a Dangerous Goods card within the United States. The renewal procedure is the same as the initial application process. The application must be completed and submitted accompanied with the original membership fee and mailed to the FAST Commercial Driver Program in Niagara Falls.
